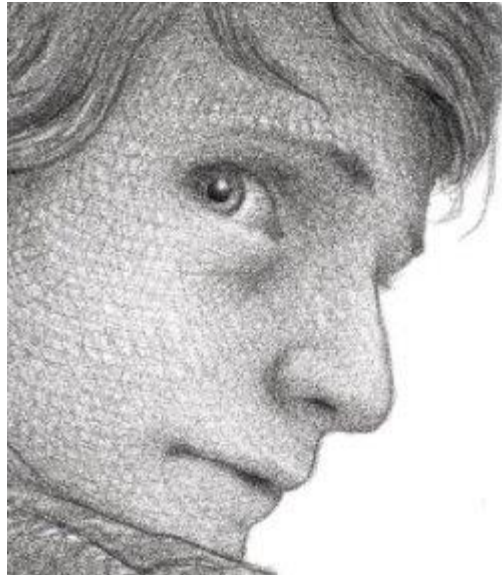


Action Lead
